Thank you for your entry for the Mór Oil Galway Summer Rally 2010. **Your seeded number is on the website, [www.galwaymotorclub.ie](http://www.galwaymotorclub.ie)**

Please note if your assigned Car Number is greater than 131 in the Main Field greater than 10 in the Junior Rally and 5 in the Mini Rally or 5 in the Historic Rally you are a Reserve Entry and will be contacted by the entries secretary as soon as a vacancy arises.

**Drivers Briefing.**

**Time: 8.45am Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> August.**

**Venue: Loughrea Hotel & Spa, Loughrea.**

It is compulsory for all drivers to attend Drivers Briefing. To this end, 10 competitors will be drawn at random at the briefing, and any crews whose number is drawn, and who are not present (both crew members must be present), will incur a 2 minute penalty as per Appendix 25, 3.2. The venue is The Loughrea Hotel & Spa at 8.45am on Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> August.

**Ceremonial Start** Attendance at the Ceremonial Start is compulsory for cars and crews of competitors numbered 1 to 10 inclusive, and the Top Galway Motor Club Seeded competitors. It will take place in the Main Street, Loughrea, Co. Galway on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> August at 20.00hrs. The start will be in seeded competition number order and there will be a one minute intervals for all crews.

Time cards will not be issued. Crew members must wear their approved racing suits.

A Start Assembly Area will be established immediately before the Ceremonial Start. Competing cars must be in the holding area before 19.30hrs. The holding area will open at 19.00 hrs.

**Sign-on for recce is on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> August between 20.00 - 22.00 hrs or Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> August 08.00 - 12.00 hrs in the Loughrea Hotel & Spa, Loughrea. (Rally HQ).**

**Pace note making is strictly from 08.30hrs - 17.00 hrs on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> August.**

**We expect competitors to adhere to the maximum speed limit of 60kph during recce.**

**Competitors are reminded that speed checks may be placed at random by the organisers and general patrols of the special stages will take place.**

In relation to recce cars may we remind you that commercial vans i.e. Transit/Vito type vehicles cannot be used. Please ensure that recce stickers are displayed prominently on your vehicle prior to departure from the hotel car park. You are reminded that as per Appendix 29 Section 4.6.1 Reconnaissance is limited to a maximum of three passes per stage or any part thereof. The Organisers will have personnel in place at appropriate points along the route to police the rules of Recce. Please present your car for **Mechanical Scrutiny at the T.B.F. Thompson Plant Ltd, Station Road, Loughrea, Co. Galway.** Mechanical Scrutiny will be open from 14.00hrs to 20.00hrs on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> August 2010. Your due time for scrutiny will be posted on [www.galwaymotorclub.ie](http://www.galwaymotorclub.ie) from Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2010. Late penalties will apply at scrutiny and paper scrutiny. All cars must be in Parc Ferme and Competitors must have completed Paper Scrutiny thirty minutes after leaving mechanical scrutiny.

Documentation Scrutiny is at the Loughrea Hotel & Spa and on Saturday Night Parc Ferme is at the Old Supervalu Carpark, Loughrea.

Door Decals and Mechanical Scrutiny Forms will be available at the Mechanical Scrutiny area. Decals must be on the car and you must have the first section of the Mechanical Scrutiny form completed *before* presenting the car for Mechanical Scrutiny.

Documentation Scrutiny will be in the Loughrea Hotel & Spa, Loughrea Galway from 14.00hrs to 20.30hrs on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> August 2010.

All service vehicles must be in Service prior to 9am sharp on Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> August 2010 - there will be no exceptions. The service area will be open from 20.00hrs to 22.00hrs on Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> August. The Service Area is in the Livestock Mart, Loughrea. No trailers are allowed in the service area by order of the COC.

Ground Sheets are required in the service area and frequent inspections of the use of Ground sheets will be carried out during the event by the Service Area Manager.

The Finish Ramp will be located at The Loughrea Rea Hotel & Spa. On Sunday evening the Parc Ferme will be located directly across the road from the Loughrea Hotel & Spa.

Licences must be handed in at recce sign-on.

Competitors are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure that their competition Licences and IRDS are in order before the weekend of the event. Competitors failing to present current competition licences and IRDS letter will not be allowed to start the event - without exception.
